The Batessa wows with a sleek, compact design. Its modern matte black stainless steel housing exudes simple elegance and can be given a completely unique style with the Mix & Match concept. Styling choices include high-end housing elements and portafilter designs, such as classy acacia wood, acrylic, epoxy, or concrete, making the machine's aesthetics adaptable to any kitchen. But it's not just the look, of course, but also the espresso that can be custom-tailored – by simply using the intuitive display and its many settings. Thanks to a proportional-integral-derivative (PID) controller that constantly checks and adapts temperature against the one selected, the brewing temperature can be precisely adjusted in 1°C steps. A built-in gauge also offers perfect control over brewing pressure, and with a force of up to 16 bars, the Batessa extracts every espresso with utmost precision. Featuring pre-infusion programs and seven steam programs, the machine coaxes superbly fine, intense flavors as well as a rich crema from each coffee bean. Output can be programmed for either one or two cups.

Simple operation for stress-free sipping

The quality the Batessa perhaps most stands for is "efficiency." The dual thermoblock and actively heated brew group ensure quick readiness and energy-efficient operation. Thanks to the dual pump system, espresso and milk froth can be made at the same time and entirely independent of each

other. By preheating the cups, the passively heated cup rest helps to keep the espresso from cooling off too quickly. So that each cup can be enjoyed without worries, the machine also comes with many easy-maintenance features. Thanks to the puck drainage, pipes and tubes remain free of impurities from coffee residues (puck = coffee grounds). The 2.5-liter water tank is equipped with a water level sensor and a water filter, the latter there to prevent scale build-up. The drip tray is removable for easy cleaning, and the professional 360° no-burn steam wand is designed so that milk won't bake onto it during frothing. Finally, high-quality materials and precise workmanship guarantee a long lifespan.

Matching gear for even greater coffee bliss

The Batessa comes with a 58-mm portafilter (double spout), singlewall filter baskets, a milk pitcher, tamper, blind basket, and cleaning tools. Additional accessories are available separately. For ultimate flavor perfection, GRAEF recommends the matching on-demand coffee grinder CM1012. Featuring a timer and stepless grind size adjustment, this highquality flat burr grinder yields optimal results for each desired coffee type - ensuring never-ending delights and "perfect harmony" in each cup.

GRAEF's fresh take on coffee

To newly align its Coffee World, GRAEF has already started developing a special strategy last year, establishing a "coffeeworld department" supported by external experts such as Raffaele Iuliucci, barista und Espresso Italiano Champion of 2018, as well as specialists from the former GRAEF CoffeeKitchen.
